THE STORY OF WALSINGHAM: ENGLAND'S NATIONAL SHRINE OF OUR LADY

EWTN Presents. A documentary about the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, once the fourth most visited shrine in Christendom. It was first established in 1061, after Our Lady appeared to a local noblewoman requesting that she build a replica of the Holy House of Nazareth, where the Annunciation had taken place. Destroyed at the order of Henry VIII, the shrine was reestablished in the 19th century and has again emerged as a centre of Catholic life in our day. *Sunday 23, 16:00; Thursday 27, 9:00; Friday 28, 3:00; Saturday 29, 21:00.
